Computer users often disagree about which operating system is best: Mac or PC. Cyclic (2019) stated that one operating system is not better than the other, but that one may be better suited for different purposes than the other. One researcher is stating that:

Macs are often the best option for users who want to work with video or picture. (Chapman2019). Macs are also very user friendly, which may benefit researchers who are new to computers. PCs, however, run Microsoft Office Suite like Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc. and that a PC is their best option because it can run Microsoft Word and PowerPoint the easiest way. (Cyclic, 2019, p. 48).

Conversely, Jones (2019) disagreed with the statement that Macs work with graphics such as video and pictures better than PCs, stating that PCs can be modified to work as well as Macs.
